FANTASTIC SALES

This year's fundraiser has been a wonderful success thanks to the effort of all our parents. Our gross sales topped more than \$45,000, with profits after expenses and product costs expected to be about \$20,000. Limo winners will be announced after sales money has been collected. A tentative date has been set for Nov. 8.

ORDERS DISTRIBUTED WEDNESDAY ONLY

Fundraiser items will be distributed from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. Wednesday, Sept. 27, in the school gym. An adult representative must be present to collect the items. PSA volunteers and HFS Student Council members will be available to assist. Kudos to all the parents and students who volunteer. Only parents who help sort candy bars in the afternoon may pick up their orders after all sorting has been completed. Parish service hours will be awarded.

Parents who fail to pick up their fundraiser items Wednesday must pay a \$25.00 fine. No freezer space is available at school to store cookie dough or cold food items. Reminder calls Wednesday evening to those who have not yet picked up items will start at approximately 6:15 p.m. to allow time to travel to the school.

NO DISTRIBUTION IMMEDIATELY AFTER SCHOOL

Please be considerate. Items will not be available for distribution immediately after school to allow sufficient time to sort boxes, to prevent after-school traffic congestion, and to allow PSA volunteers and school staff members a break before evening duties.

CHECK FLOOR FOR BOXED ORDERS & CANDY BARS CHECK STAGE FOR COOKIE DOUGH AND COLD FOOD ITEMS

After entering the gym, please check for fundraiser items in two places: on the gym floor AND on the gym stage. Parents may have items waiting for them at both locations. Gift book and candy bar orders will be available at classroom stations on the gym floor. These boxes may contain chocolate items and should not be left in a car or any other location where they might melt. Cookie dough and cold food items will be distributed from the stage at the front of the gym. Cookie dough items should be stored in a freezer until being distributed to customers. The dough may not be left out for extended periods.

MISSING OR DAMAGED ITEMS

SIGN OUT

Before leaving the gym, please sign out at the table near the inside door manned by PSA volunteers.

COLLECTING AND SUBMITTING MONEY

Money is to be collected from customers when they receive their items. Money must be turned in to the school on or before 8:15 a.m. Wednesday, Oct. 18. Failure to collect money from a buyer does not mean the items can be returned to the school. Items cannot be returned to the fundraising company unless there is a problem with a product.

If at all possible, families should ask customers to make out checks to them. Families should then write one check for each of their children to Holy Family School. (Writing one check for multiple children causes additional bookkeeping time since funds are recorded, balanced, and deposited by class.) Checks should be made out to Holy Family School and not Great American. Cash and money orders also are acceptable. If families do submit checks written by a customer, the name of the student seller SHOULD BE IN THE MEMO LINE OF THE CHECK.

Please note, there were order sheet pricing mistakes on some children's order forms. Parents need to use the CORRECTED TOTALS supplied with their orders. Please, do not forget to add your candy bar total to the Gift Book/Cookie Dough total supplied by Great American.
