### **Child Health Examination Form Information**

Holy Family School students entering **Kindergarten** or **Sixth Grade**, and all new students from out of state, are required to present an Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination. Forms from other states cannot be accepted. Missouri physicians must use the Illinois State form to record our school physicals.

Kindergarten and Sixth Grade students must present this form *in order to begin* the 2020-2021 School Year at Holy Family School.

Forms should be submitted at School Business Day held in August prior to the start of the school year.

Sixth graders cannot use their sports physicals to satisfy this sixth grade requirement; however, the Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination can be used as their sports physical.

The form should list any medications the child takes routinely, diet restrictions or needs, special equipment needed, and known allergies.

<u>Parents</u> must fill out the Health History portion (on the back of the health form) and sign and date the form. *The parent signature is a state requirement.* 

Every child shall present proof of having received immunizations against preventable communicable diseases. There is room on the front page of the health form for this information. This information MUST be signed and dated (or stamped) by a health care professional. If a health care professional chooses, this information may be included on a separate sheet.

A diabetes screening (questionnaire) must be included as a required part of each health examination and the health care provider must document results of the diabetes risk assessment on the Certificate of Child Health Examination form.

### **Dental Examination Form Information**

- Holy Family School students entering Kindergarten, Grade 2, and Grade
   6 are required to provide a School Dental Examination Form.
- Examinations must be performed by a licensed dentist, who must sign and date the form.
- Kindergarten and Grade 2 students <u>must</u> present their dental form on Holy Family School Business Day in August prior to the start of school. The examination must have been completed within nine months prior to the start of the new school year.
- Sixth grade students only have until May 1, 2021, to present their form. Sixth grade dental examinations must have been completed within the 18 months prior to their May 1, 2021, deadline.
- The newest revised ILLINOIS form must be used. Dentists from Missouri must use the Illinois form.
- Those unable to obtain the required dental examination may be able to present a signed and dated alternate Dental Examination Wavier Form if certain state guidelines are met: including having a child who is enrolled in the free and reduced lunch program but not covered by private or public dental insurance (Medicaid/All Kids); having a child enrolled in the free and reduced lunch program who is ineligible for public insurance (Medicaid/All Kids); having a child enrolled in Medicaid/All Kids, but the family is unable to find a dentist or dental clinic in the community able to see their child and will accept Medicaid/All Kids; or having a child who does not have any type of dental insurance and there are no low-cost dental clinics in the community that will see the child.

# **Eye Examination Information**

All students entering **Kindergarten** and any **student enrolling for the first time** are required to submit an Illinois Eye Examination Report. Holy Family School requires this form be presented on School Business Day in August prior to the start of school year.

Examinations must be performed by a licensed optometrist or medical doctor who specializes in eye examinations, as specified in Illinois Department of Public Health administrative rules.

The examination must be completed within one year *prior to* the first day of school the year the child enters kindergarten or Holy Family School.

Rather than submitting an Eye Examination Report, an Eye Examination Waiver may be accepted if one of the following applies:

- If child is enrolled in medical assistance/All Kids, but the family is unable to locate in their community a licensed optometrist or a medical doctor who performs eye examinations to examine the child and who will accept medical assistance/All Kids;
- The child does not have any type of medical or vision/eye care insurance coverage, the child does not qualify for medical assistance/All Kids, there are no low-cost vision/eye clinics in the community that will examine the child, and the family has exhausted all other means and does not have sufficient income to provide the child with an eye examination;
- Other undue burden or lack of access to a licensed optometrist or medical doctor who performs eye examinations prevents the child from obtaining an eye examination.



## State of Illinois Eye Examination Report

Illinois law requires that proof of an eye examination by an optometrist or physician (such as an ophthalmologist) who provides eye examinations be submitted to the school no later than October 15 of the year the child is first enrolled or as required by the school for other children. The examination must be completed within one year prior to the first day of the school year the child enters the Illinois school system for the first time. The parent of any child who is unable to obtain an examination must submit a waiver form to the school.
