



## HALLOWEEN REMINDERS

On Thursday, Oct. 29, students may come to school dressed in their Halloween costumes. On that day, students will participate in a Halloween parade and parties.

Costumes may not include weapons, blood, or gore. Both boys' and girls' costumes should reflect modesty. Students coming to school in anything related to gangs, gangsters or inappropriate themes will be sent home.

At 8:45 a.m., the Primary Wing students will be led out from the gym foyer doors and proceed down the drive. They will stop mid-way on the drive for pictures. They will return to their classrooms through the St. Clair Avenue doors. Class order will be Grades 4, 3, 2, 1 and K.

The Jr. High wing students will follow from the St. Clair Avenue doors and proceed down the front drive. They will stop mid-way for pictures and return to their classrooms through the gym foyer doors. Class order will be Grades 8, 5, 6, and 7

Parents/grandparents are welcome to view the costume display outside in the field. Spectators may bring chairs or blankets to sit on the field side of the front drive. All spectators must wear a mask and observe social distancing. Parents may not come to the classroom parties at this time. All classroom "treats" must be purchased from a store or bakery. No home baked goods can be served.
